

GAME DRIVE VEHICLES ON MABALINGWE

APPLICABLE AREA	MABALINGWE NATURE RESERVE

1. PURPOSE

To ensure that all Game Drive Vehicles on Mabalingwe Nature Reserve are regulated according to specific rules.

2. RULES

Owners shall be limited to not more than 1 (one) game drive vehicle per dwelling, the ownership, use and control of each vehicle shall conform to the following rules:

- a) All vehicles shall be green open game viewing type vehicles
- b) All vehicles shall seat a maximum of 12 people
- c) All persons driving game vehicles anywhere on the Reserve, must have a valid driver’s license.
- d) No weapons are to be carried on game drives.

3. REGULATIONS

- a) All green game drive vehicles must be registered with the MCPA and be issued with a Mabalingwe registration number.
- b) The registration number must be visible at all times when driving in Mabalingwe.

4. HOW TO REGISTER YOUR VEHICLE

To register your vehicle, please contact the MCPA Systems Manager to arrange an inspection of the vehicle.

After the vehicle is approved, you will be issued a Mabalingwe registration number.

5. COST INVOLVED

The cost of the registration number plates will be for the owner’s account.

The current cost is R250 for a set of number plates.
